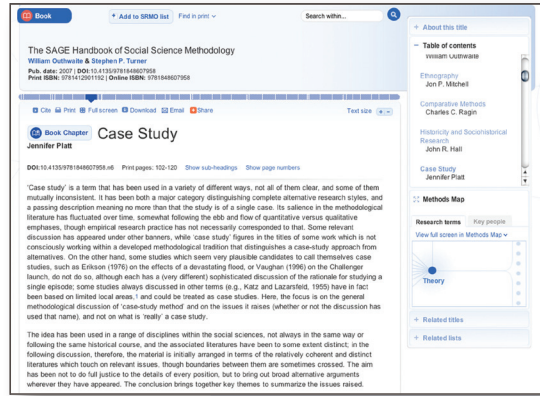
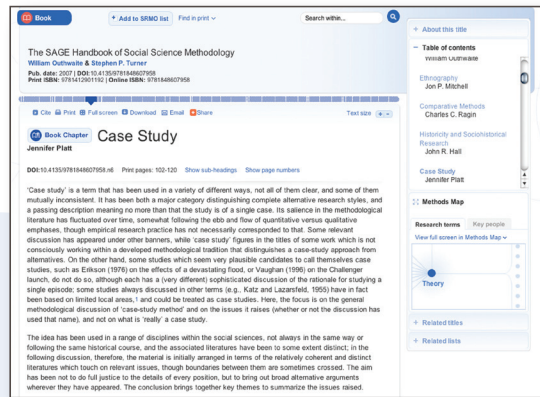


# CONTENT PAGE FEATURES:



- Add this chapter, book or article to an SRMO List.
- Find this book in print in your library.
- Search within the content.
- Cite this article in the format of your choice.
- Download, email or share this article with colleagues via your social network or bookmarking site of choice.

- View (or hide) page numbers – this feature easily allows you to reference the right page, just as if you were looking at a print copy.
- Enlarge or reduce the text size on screen for accessibility.
- Read a description of the book you are viewing.
- View the table of contents for the book.
- See any ancillary materials such as acknowledgements, prefaces and further details about the authors.
- Find where this content sits on the Methods Map and see related titles for more on your topic of interest.

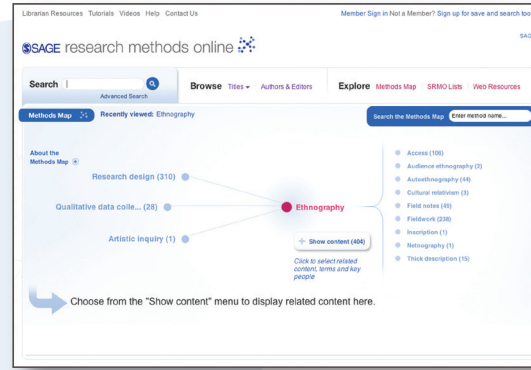


# SRMO LISTS FEATURES:

- See all the lists you have created. By clicking on the padlock symbol, you can choose to keep your lists private or share them with other SRMO users.

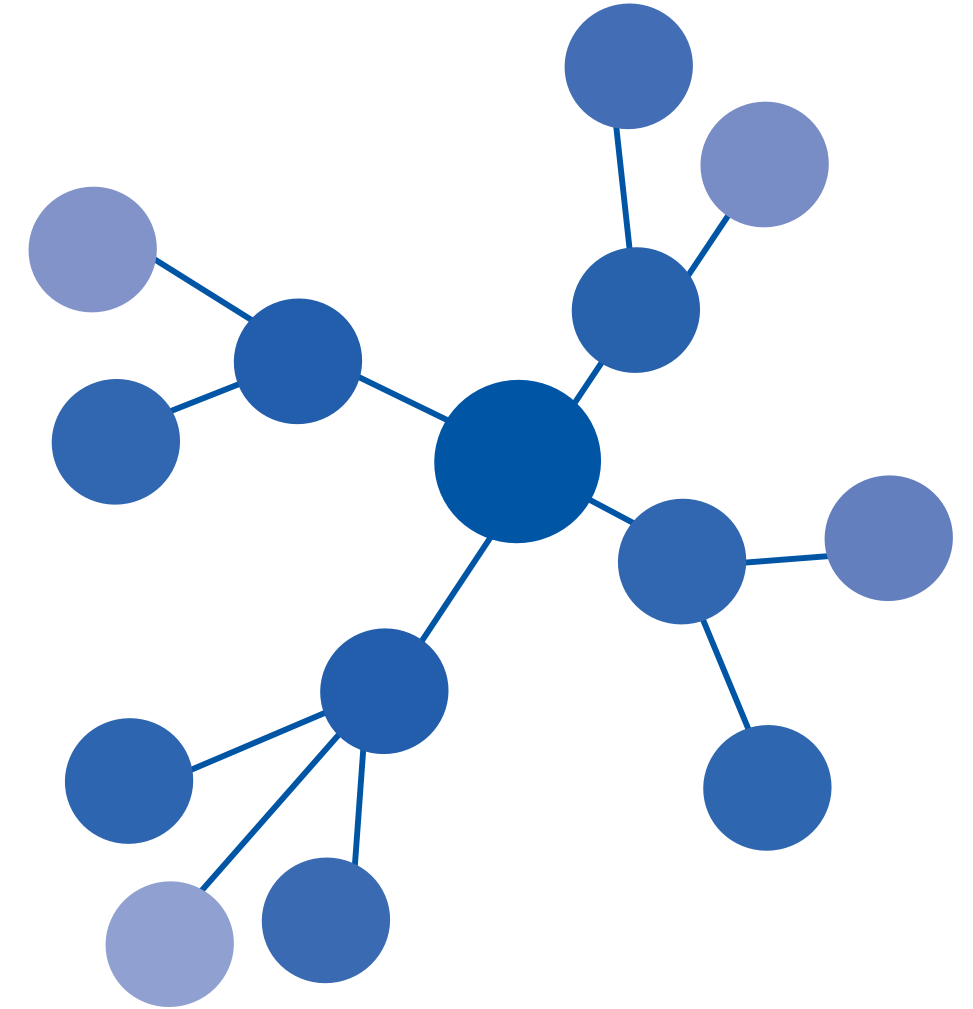
- Find lists by topic.

# METHODS MAP FEATURES:



- See what types of content are available for your methods term – dictionaries, books, encyclopaedias, journal articles and/ or videos.

- View the parent categories which your search term falls under. Click on one of these for more on other methods you might use.
- See the sub topics which fall up under your search term within the Methods Map. Click on these to find more detail to help you with your current method.
- Click 'Add to search criteria' to view content related to the methods term – you can compile a list of content related to as many different terms as you like – or 'Remove from search criteria' to remove content related to this term from your results list.
- Sort your results by relevance, title or publication date.
- Print, save or share your search results by email or social media.
- View options – choose the amount of detail you want to see in your search results.

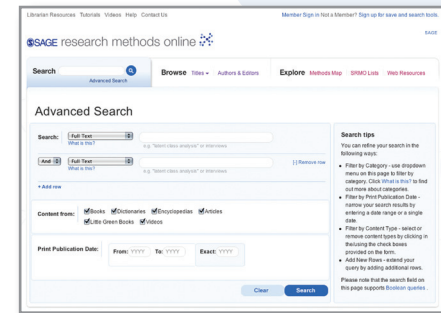

SAGE Research Methods Online (SRMO) is the place to go for researchers, lecturers and students studying social science subjects.

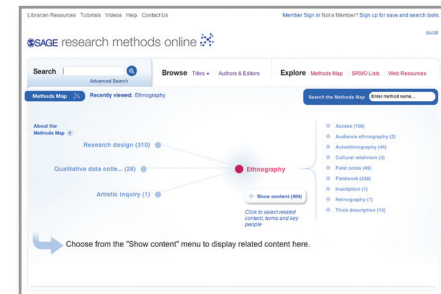
SRMO helps you to answer your research methods and research design questions as you explore over 100,000 pages of book, journal and reference content.

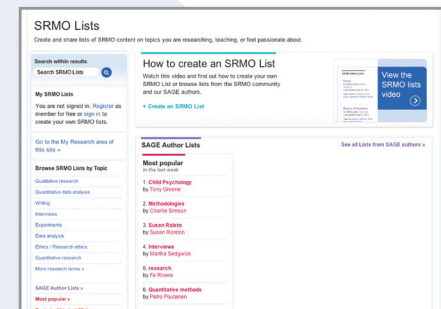
### Search

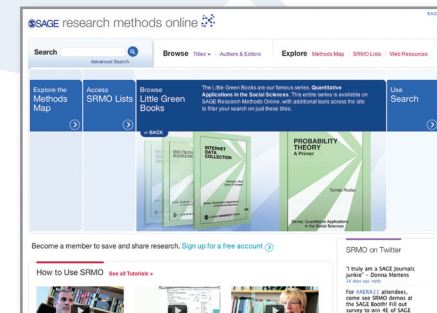
### Methods Map

### SRMO Lists

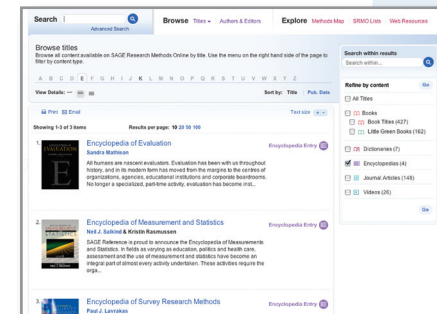
SRMO Lists are lists of content within the product that our users have selected and want to share through this product. You can create your own lists, either for private use or to share with others on the site.

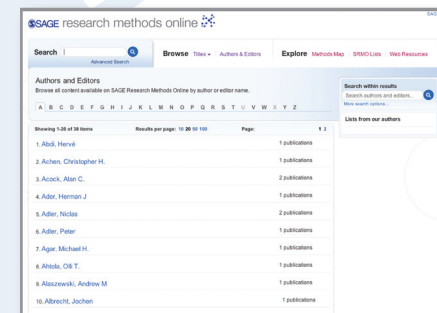

### Browse by Publication Type

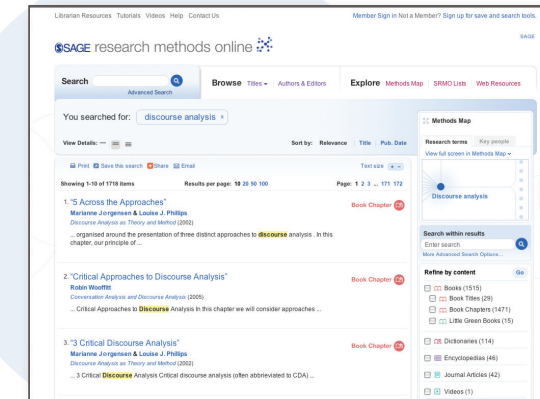

## SEARCH FEATURES:



- Predictive text helps you to find the content you need.
- View options – choose the amount of detail you want to see in your search results.
- Sort options – sort by relevance, pub date or title.
- Print, save, share or email your search results.
- Change the size of the text.
- Easily identify the type of content you are viewing with content icons.
- Hover over a search result to read the abstract.
- Add a search result to your 'SRMO list' and/ or export a citation in the format you need.
- Click directly through to view your search term in the Methods Map.
- See who the key authors are who have written on your topic.
- Search within your results to refine your search further, or choose 'Advanced Search Options' to search content published in a particular timeframe, or to search by full text, title, author, or ISBN.
- Refine your search by selecting the type of content you need. Looking for a brief definition? Click 'Dictionaries'.
- Refine your search by methods map terms to look for your search result within a particular area.
- Find 'SRMO Lists' containing relevant content.
